Active Kids Voucher

(Current Vouchers expire 31 January 2024):

Eligible players from U5 to U18 can claim and use the "Active Kids Voucher" (AKV) which gives a \$50 discount per child. The AKV can only be used once and is not transferrable.

To redeem this voucher, Parents / Guardians will need to access the **Service NSW website:** www.service.nsw.gov.au for each of their eligible children using their Medicare card. The AKV code is then used during the online registration process when registering their child on the "**DRIBL**" website (see below). Please bring-printout of AKV to registration.

Working With Children Checks (WWCC):

Under the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012*, it is now a requirement of Football NSW that **any** person, who has direct face-to-face contact with a person under 18 years of age, either in a paid or volunteer role, **must** hold a WWC Number.

<u>ALL</u> people who volunteer in our club as committee members, coaches, managers etc. are required to supply a WWC Number.

The WWC number <u>must be provided to Penrith FC before</u> any coach, manager or volunteer registration will be approved.

BBQ Duty:

Each team is required to help on the BBQ during the season. Teams are rostered on for a short duration before each home game.

REFEREES

- Ages U5-U11 Referees are <u>NOT</u> provided by NFA
 - Parents / Coaches are required to referee games in agreement with the opposition team
- Ages U12 and above Referees are allocated by the NFA (Nepean Football Association).
 - Where no referee is appointed, teams are to negotiate suitable person to undertake duties

Conduct of Players and Spectators:

- There is a total ban at all grounds within Nepean District during junior fixtures.

- Some clubs have a complete ban on alcohol, so please check with the host club if playing away.
